

How many times do you spot him in the book?



The Bakau Pasir (Rhizophora stylosa) is a tree that can be found in mangrove forests like Chek Jawa or Pulau Semakau. It can grow in salty or brackish water. It has stilt roots that spread over a wide area to keep the tree stable.




